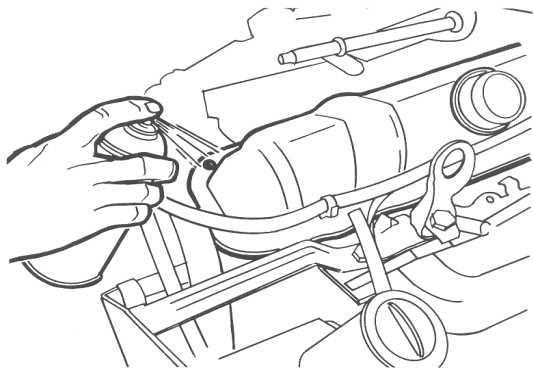

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Provide adequate ventilation.
2. Warm up engine and turn off. Surfaces should be free of oil, dirt and grease.
3. Shake can well. Note: The product does not require a ball agitator. For best results, the aerosol can should be at room temperature before spraying.
4. Eliminate any internal pressure within the assembly.
5. Apply the sealant using the extension tube and liberally coat the entire leak area.
6. Wipe off excess sealant, allow one minute to dry, then reapply. For best results use a minimum of three coats.



5. Allow the product to dry for at least one hour before returning the engine to service.

Note: Not for use on high pressure applications, such as

exhaust or head gaskets.

For Cleanup

1. Turn can upside-down and spray to clear nozzle.
2. Clean hands with Permatex® brand hand cleaners.
